Repeat Prescribing

From a practice point of view the only time a prescription should take longer than the 48 hours is if the patient needs to attend for a review which means the prescription cannot be processed in the normal way.

Dr Hems pointed out that regardless of whether drugs are recommended by the Hospital it is the doctors responsibility to write the prescription and have the reviews in place. We are now looking to extend some areas of prescribing to a 12 month review

- Proposed erection of new three bedroom house and garage - St Mary's Road Proposed side extension to existing bungalow to form an additional bedroom - Four Acres.
- 1st floor and roof space extension and alts to provide additional residential accommodation - Fisherman's Lodge, Newport Cottages - objections raised
