

## MINUTES FROM HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 17 APRIL 2007

- The following planning application was considered:  
06/07/0314/F alterations and extensions to dwelling, new conservatory and extension to existing boundary wall – The Cottage, The Street, Hemsby for Mr Chandler – Parish Councillors have no objections, however concerns were expressed at the fact the driveway has not been completed. It was agreed no action would be taken at present, if it is not completed once current planning application has been completed then action would be taken.
- The following are the decisions Great Yarmouth Borough Council have made on planning applications:  
06/07/0216/F conservatory to side 41 Sweetacres for Mr & Mrs Harvey – no objections  
06/07/0158/F det bungalow and garage 68 Common Road (adj) for Mrs Chapman – granted.
- Great Yarmouth Borough Council has given permission for works to be carried out on trees that are covered by a Tree Preservation Order:  
Coach House Res Care Home crown lift tree TPO/2007/09 and 9 Homestead Gardens  
TPO/2007/08 remove dead wood, tidy trunk and crown by removing small re-growth from main trunk and branches.
- Litter pick -GYB Services have been requested to carry out a litter pick on The Street and Taylors Loke.
- Dredging - a letter is to be sent to Communities and Local Government objecting strongly to Hansons application to extract sand and gravel off our section of coast.
- Wind turbines at the Old Met Station was discussed and it was left with the Chairman of the Parish Council to discuss with SLP the prospect of an exhibition to allow parishioners to express their concerns, etc before a planning application is received.
- The next Parish Council meeting will be held on Monday 21 May 2007 at the Pavilion, Waters Lane Hemsby – commencing at 8 00pm.
