

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 17 JULY 2007

- Due to concerns expressed by parishioners a bus service for the residents of the Fakes Road area is being reinstated in September 2007 – a timetable will be available shortly, during the summer there will be a temporary service.
- St Marys Close was judged for the Great Yarmouth & Gorleston in Bloom competition on Friday 13 July 2007 and they have won a couple of categories. Parish Councillors gave a big thanks to all those parishioners that made a special effort to make the area extra special.
- Playing field car park - it was agreed a Notice will be erected on the playing field car park stating 'No Overnight Parking'. People are using it as a public car park, when it has been provided for people using the Village Hall, Sporting Club, Pavilion and playing field.
- The following planning applications were considered:
 - 06/07/0533/F ext to existing bedroom 9 Four Acres Est. for Mr Taylor – PCllrs have no objections
 - 06/07/0564/F dem of existing single storey building. Construction of two new storeys Bowling Centre & Function Room - Bobbies Diner for Horning Pleasurecraft Ltd – PCllrs have no objections
 - 06/07/0550/F alt & ext Byway Yarmouth Road for Mr & Mrs Cloney – PCllrs have no objections
- Great Yarmouth Borough Council has granted permission for the following planning application: 06/07/0410/F Alt & ext enlarge kitchen & form dining area and bedroom with en-suite 1 Ryelands for Mr & Mrs Rowand.
- Parish Council website - to date the Parish Council website has had 4090 hits, so there is a lot of interest.
- Flood sirens - a letter has been sent to Great Yarmouth Borough Council advising them that the Parish Council would like to see the 'flood sirens' remain.
- Kingsway service road - concerns were expressed at the way people are parking their vehicles in Kingsway service road which is causing a problem for buses to stop – a letter has been sent to the Police and First Bus asking them to investigate.
- Speeding traffic - a letter has been sent to the Police advising them of speeding traffic down North Road and Winterton Road.
- Overgrown trees and hedgerow - letters have been sent to several properties where trees and hedgerows are causing an obstruction.
- The next Parish Council meeting will be held on Monday 6 Sept 2007, at the Parish Office, Hemsby – commencing at 7.30pm.
