

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 19 JUNE 2007

- Junction Fakes Road/Newport Road - the Parish Council is applying for double yellow lines on both sides of the road. This is due to the problems with vehicles parking close to the entrance at Fakes Road.
- Footpaths in the parish – maps are now available from the Video shop in Kingsway.
- Belle Aire Chalet site Great Yarmouth Borough Council Planning Enforcement Officer be requested to check site to see who is living there for 46 weeks of the year.
- St Marys Close has been entered into Great Yarmouth in Bloom competition.
- The following planning applications were considered:
 - 06/070461/F variation of condition 4 of PP 06/07/0016/F to change of use of Unit 5 from A1 shop to Lauderette Saturns Amusement Arcade – Horning Pleasurecraft – PCllrs have no objections
 - 06/07/0460/F variation of conditions 4 PP 06/07/0016/F to change of use of Unit 4 from A1 to A2 Saturns amusement Arcade for Horning Pleasurecraft – PCllrs have no objections
 - 06/07/0520/F extension to provide four additional rooms with integral shower rooms Church Farm Residential Care Home – the Parish Council is concerned due to extension being close to the property boundary and windows overlooking neighbouring properties.
