## MINUTES FOR HEMSBY ANNUAL PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 21 MAY 2007

- Chairman - PCllr Reynolds was re-elected as Chairman
- Vice Chairman - PCllr Bevan was re-elected as Vice Chairman
- Parish Councillors appointed to organisations in the parish:  
PCllr Reynolds was appointed as the Parish Council representative on the Village Hall Committee.  
PCllr Kyriacou was appointed as the Parish Council representative on the Sporting Club Committee.  
PCllr Randell and PCllr Bevan were appointed as Parish Council representatives on the Poors Land Trust.
- Burial Ground gates - It was agreed for the Summer the Burial Ground gates will remain open until 7pm.
- Parish Council Accounts for year ending 31 March 2007 had had an Internal Audit and were approved and signed off at this meeting. A Notice is being displayed in the Parish Council Notice Boards advising parishioners they have an opportunity to view or take a copy of the accounts

06/07/0355/0 one bungalow and garage and two semi-detached houses and garages Denesgate (land to rear of 47 Martham Road for Mr Carter – PCllrs have no objections.
- Great Yarmouth Borough Council have made the following decisions on planning applications:  
06/07/0199/F installation of a cash machine (ATM) and ext of access ramp Spar 5-7 Kingsway – granted  
06/07/0014/F entrance canopy, extn to car park, demolition of 2 chalets, erection of new holiday chalet and 4 static caravans – Hemsby Beach Holiday Village – granted  
06/07/0243/F extension to kitchen 30 Mill Road for Mr Allen – granted  
06/07/198/A fascias surround 5-7 Kingsway (Spar) granted
