

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL 19 NOVEMBER 2007

- Tenders for carrying out works to Parish Council assets were discussed - the grasscutting contract for the burial ground and the playing field was given to NCS Ltd, the beach cleaning contract was given to Mr K Chaney, the Cleaner Handyman contract was given to Mr P Randell and the gardening contract was given to M/s Ellis.
- Street lighting scheme - residents of Lexington Close have informed the Parish Council they do not wish to have a street lighting scheme for their road. Parish Councillors agreed to Precept for a street lighting scheme for another road in the parish.
- Extension to the playing field and pavilion - there has been a meeting with the Consultants dealing with the bid to go to FF to extend the sports field and the Pavilion, there will be another meeting in December 2007, with a view to submitting the Parish Councils bid in the new year
- A donation of £100 is to be given to the Norfolk Accident Rescue Service.
- Grants for groups in the parish - the following groups in the parish have been given a Grant:

Youth club,
Hemsby Bowles Club
Hemsby 1st Brownies.
- House numbers for properties in North Road – this is to be an Agenda item for the December 2007 meeting. This is due to a concern from a resident who had needed emergency assistance at night.
- Burial ground - quotations are being obtained for crown lifting the trees on both side boundaries of the burial ground.

06/07/0891/0 erection of a three bedroom bungalow and garage The Beech Trees (land at rear of) North Road for Witheridge, Bould & Hannant – PCllrs object on grounds backland development
06/07/0963/F construction of double garage The Vineries Res Care Home – PCllrs have no objections
06/07/0968/F proposed boiler house, oil storage compound The Coach House Res Care Home PCllrs object on the horizontal flue – this building is already there and there are problems for neighbours with fumes from this chimney.
06/07/0979/F erection of 2.4m high paling fence to boundary Sundowner Holiday Park for Sundowner Ltd – PCllrs have no objections
06/07/0983/F impr form raise decking dining area and improve to frontage Hollywood Diner Beach Road for Geoff Watling – PCllrs no objections
06/07/0971/F proposed bungalow for holiday use and garage 'Dun Roamin'(plot adj) Four Acres for Mr Mullany – PCllrs no objections
06/07/0989/CU 5 The Jasmynes change of use from holiday to residential – PCllrs strongly object on grounds there is no all year round occupancy in the area.
