

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING OCTOBER 2007

- Highways - Norfolk County Council is considering siting a roundabout at the junction with Ormesby Road, The Street, Yarmouth Road and Waters Lane.
- Flooding - sand and sand bags - in an emergency sand is being stored behind the Pavilion and the sand bags are available from Shirley Weymouth telephone 731625.
- Zebra crossing - Norfolk County Council has been requested to look into providing a zebra crossing at Newport Road junction on safety grounds for youngsters catching the school bus. The Police will be carrying out speed checks on all main roads in the village.
- Fakes Road Improvement Association are to repair the concrete footpath leading up Fakes Road and then site bollards adjacent to the speed ramps, this will prevent any further damage to the footpath.
- Young Citizen Guild are being approached to litter pick the roads in the holiday area during the summer season for a donation from the Parish Council.
- Great Yarmouth Borough Council solicitor is being asked to give advice on alcohol being taken onto the Burial Ground.
- TPO - permission has been given by Great Yarmouth Borough Council to crown lift the trees adjacent to Kingsway on the Burial Ground, Kingsway.
- The following planning applications were considered:
06/07/0839/F alt & imp to entrances at beach & valley car parks, stopping up of extg exit road & create restaurant patio area for Geof Watling – PCllrs are concerned with the stopping up of the road due to the fact of delivery vehicles having to reverse with the holidaymakers gaining access to the beach
06/07/0879/Fconservatory 23 The Street –PCllrs have no objections.
- Great Yarmouth Borough Council have made decisions on the following planning applications:
06/07/0564/F dem of existing buildings & construction of two storey bowling centre with function room on first floor Bobbies Diner – Horning Pleasurecraft – granted with conditions on landscaping – car park & access
06/07/0716/R additional property at 33 Ormesby Road (in back garden) refused.
- TPO - Great Yarmouth Borough Council has given permission for beech trees to be crown lifted at Beechgrove - The Street.
- Street lighting scheme - letters are being sent to residents in Lexington Close to obtain their views on having street lights installed in their road, they would be the low emission type that direct the light to the ground not causing any intrusion into properties.
- Shoreline Management Plan - a letter is being sent to Great Yarmouth Borough Council putting forward parishioners views on the Shoreline Management Plan.
- St Marys Close - a letter of congratulations is being sent to St Marys Close residents who won 2 Great Yarmouth and Gorleston in Bloom Awards, as a gesture the Parish Council are giving them a bag of daff bulbs.
- The next Parish Council meeting will be held on Monday 19 November 2007, at the Parish Office, Hemsby – commencing at 7.30pm.
