

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 17 SEPTEMBER 2007

- Shoreline Management Plan – it was agreed there will be a public meeting on 1 October 2007 in the Village Hall at 7 00pm with Great Yarmouth Borough Council Officers to discuss the views of parishioners – don't miss putting your views forward.
- Newport Road - Norfolk County Council is asking for the Parish Councils views on double yellow lines at Newport Road Fakes Road junction, this was discussed, a letter in reply is to be sent totally agreeing with the proposal.
- Street lighting - Great Yarmouth Borough Council will be progressively replacing street lamp posts in the parish to a different style. This is to be in line with Norfolk County Councils specification, due to environmental requirements and light emissions.
- Homewatch Administrator – Tom Gill gave details of how the scheme works. They would like to have more areas in the parish covered by the scheme – anyone interested – can you telephone the Parish Clerk on 01493 731625 for further details – if your area is covered by Homewatch then several insurance companies reduce your house insurance premium by 5% - it is really worthwhile.
- Tenders - the Parish Council is going out to tender for 2008/09 for beach cleaning, grasscutting and toilet/handyman. Notices are being displayed in all Notice boards – if you would like a specification please telephone the Parish Clerk 01493 731625.
- Grants available to groups in the parish - the Parish Council is looking for Groups in the parish to apply for a Grant.  - 06/07/0788/F dem of vehicle showroom and erection of MOT testing building Crossroads Garage for Mr Mudge – PCllrs had no objections, however they felt there should be a condition of planning that a footpath be installed all the way around the perimeter of the garage.
