

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 21 APRIL 2008

- The Glebe - concerns were expressed at the fact that the main drain sewer were blocked again in The Glebe, which was due to fat from business premises putting fat down the main - the Environmental Health Department are investigating the matter with the possibility of prosecution.
- Dog fouling – Great Yarmouth Borough Council Environmental Rangers are delivering letters to properties where dog fouling is occurring and additional stickers will be placed around the village reminding people not to allow their dogs to foul.
- Kingsway service road - Norfolk County Council is to site a dropped kerb adjacent to the bus stop in Kingsway service road to enable disabled and people with pushchairs and prams to cross the service road to the Spar Shop.
