

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 21 JANUARY 2008

- Police report given by PCSO::
Chalets being broken into - investigations are being carried out
Newport Road – cars parking on the footpath – this practice has stopped – PCllrs reported this is not the case cars are still parking on the footpath – this will be investigated further.
St Marys Close – the problems with parents driving into this area when dropping the children off to school has stopped, but the area will be monitored.
Social Club – there has been an incident – the person has been arrested.
Minuteman speed of traffic recorder – this equipment was placed on Martham Road from 28/11 to 12/12 and the recorded number of vehicles going out of the village between 7am – 8pm was 23058 and the speed recorded was between 31 – 37 miles per hour – vehicles coming into the village from 7am to 8pm were 22488 and the speed recorded was 27.4 – 34.2 miles per hour Winterton Road had this equipment placed on the road from 28/11 to 12/12 and the recorded number of vehicles going to Winterton from 7am to 8pm was 8128 and the recorded speed was 27.3 – 37.3 miles per hour – vehicles travelling to Yarmouth between 7am and 8pm were 8298 and the speed recorded was 27 – 36 miles per hour.
