

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 16 JUNE 2008

- Speeding traffic - a parishioner expressed grave concerns at the speed of the traffic down Common Road and Mill Road three of her cats have been killed on the road – the Police are to be contacted to pay special attention to the area.
- Police report:
 - a. Crimes in Hemsby 16.05.08 – 16.06.08 are 6 assaults, 7 thefts, 3 criminal damage, 7 burglary dwelling, 1 sexual assault, 1 domestic.
 - b. The Police youth project has been offered a venue, the Pastor at Hemsby Congregational Church has kindly offered the out building at the back of the church. The youth have now formed a committee and have started to apply for funding to refurbish the venue.
 - c. The Matthew Project are coming to Hemsby every Tuesday evening for the six weeks of the summer holidays to do some outreach work around drug and alcohol use. They will be situated on the playing field car park.
- Newport Road double yellow lines - there are to be additional parking restrictions in Newport Road (double yellow lines adjacent to the amusement arcades)
- Bottle banks - with the recycling credit funds the Parish Council has employed a person to litter pick around the parish. Once a month litter will also be picked in some of the private roads in the parish.
- Parish Councillors are to complete a GP lead walk in centre consultation questionnaire
- The following planning applications were considered at that meeting:

06/08/0241/F one new barn style residential dwelling, one cattery and one stable Fengate Farm Common Road for Mr & Mrs King – PCllrs have no objections so long as the cattery and residential property are built together – the stables can be completed at a later date.

06/08/0420/F dem of vehicle showroom & erection of MOT test building Crossroads Garage revised plan – PCllrs have no objections so long as no parking where the canopy is located at the Yarmouth Road/Ormesby Road corner and no signs in that locality. PCllrs agreed they would monitor the parking situation by taking photographs.

06/08/0424/F variation of condition 4 of PP 06/07/0016/F for change of use of unit 2 from class A1 shop to A3 restaurant and café – former Saturns Amusements – Horning Pleasurecraft – PCllrs have no objections.

06/08/0465/F use of land for temp storage of top and sub soil displaced from nearby development site – Common Road Hemsby for Norfolk Homes (on R Kings land) – discussions took place into the number of vehicles fetching the surplus earth to the site and then taking to Common Road/Martham Road site – PCllrs have no objections.

06/08/0437/F proposed double garage with laundry/WC and guest accommodation within roof space – new access at 1 Beach Road for Mr Hanbury – PCllrs feel there is an overdevelopment of the site and strongly object to access being moved to Winterton Road too near the junction and visibility impaired for people leaving Beach Road.

.06/08/0263/SU conversion of existing Wardens house into two flats and front entrance ext 25 St Marys Close for GYBC – granted

.06/08/0287/F electricity voltage regulator site for a period of eight years – Kings Loke EDF – granted

.06/08/0295/F proposed minor extension to main entrance and re-roofing all flat roofs with pitched roofs to match main bungalow 35 Meadow Rise for Mr & Mrs King – granted

06/08/0286/F erection of two double garages with ancillary residential, in roof space – The Paddocks, Beach Road - granted

06/08/0178/F proposed erection of new bungalow and garage The Beech Trees (land at the rear of) North Road for Witheridge, Bould & Hannant - granted
