- Police reported:
Pit Road – the problems with parents reversing out of Pit Road when dropping the children off for school - the area will be monitored.
Graffiti around the village – this is being investigated.
'A' advertising boards obstructing Beach Road footpath – this is being looked into.
Waters Lane vehicle obstructing the footpath – this is being looked into.

- Burial Ground memorial safety check - the Parish Council contracted Great Yarmouth Borough Council to carry out a safety inspection of all the memorials on the parish burial ground. The memorials in an unsafe condition have had a notice placed on them, please contact the Parish Clerk if you wish to discuss the matter.
- Numbering properties in North Road - a majority of residents living in North Road have objected to their properties being numbered, therefore the scheme will not be going ahead.
- Bottle and can banks in Hemsby - the Parish Council agreed to take over the responsibility for the can and bottle banks on the burial ground car park, this will give additional revenue to the parish.
- Doctors meeting with Parish Councils - the Parish Council are holding regular meetings with the Doctors at Hemsby Medical Centre. At these meetings any complaints, concerns, etc will be raised – can you contact the Parish Clerk if you have any item you wish to be discussed?
