

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 17 NOVEMBER 2008

- Great Yarmouth Borough Council have made the following decision on a planning application:
06/08/0675/F prop rear ext & garage conversion 8 Fallowfield for Mr Allen – granted
- TPO – Great Yarmouth Borough Council has given permission for works to be carried out on a tree covered by a tree preservation order at The Pines Yarmouth Road.
- Hemsby Medical Centre - discussions were held into parking problems with vehicles with disability badges outside the Medical Centre, it was agreed a letter would be sent to the Practice Manager.
- Hemsby Events Committee - is erecting a Christmas tree outside the Village Hall and it will be lit on the 1st December 2008. The Church Choir and the Hemsby Primary School will be singing carols and there will be other entertainment plus Father Christmas (no presents being given to children)– there will be no admission fee. Mince pies and a hot toddy will be available.
- Bus shelters - GYB Services have re-painted the wooden bus shelters in the parish.
- Grants have been given to the following Groups in the parish:
St Marys Close Community to go towards a new flower bed
Hemsby Bowls Club to pay for score boards
Hemsby Mothers & Toddlers to go towards costs of a Xmas party for the children.
Hemsby Brownies to go towards uniforms.
- Tenders submitted for beach cleaning, toilet cleaning, litter picking and grasscutting were considered.
- The Marrams - concerns were expressed at an open cesspit – Great Yarmouth Borough Council Environmental Health Dept is to be advised as children are playing in it.
- Emergency Plan - Parish Councillors are to prepare a draft Emergency Plan for the parish, this will cover many issues not just flooding of properties.
- The next Parish Council meeting will be held 15 December 2008 at 7 30pm in the Parish Office.
