

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL 21 SEPTEMBER 2008

- Police
PCSO reported that during the last month there have been 2 crimes in the village of Hemsby.
The Princes Trust is to trim the hedges and cut the trees back in the Churchyard at the Congregational Church. They are to carry out some repairs to the Barn behind the Congregational Church which will be a youth drop in centre.
- Burial Ground sunken grave - works to be carried out to raise sunken graves

06/08/0437/F proposed double garage with laundry/wc and guest accommodation within roof space. New access off Winterton Road (B1159) 1 Beach Road for Mr O Hanbury – refused
06/08/0498/F ext to existing building to provide ground & first floor storage areas and disabled toilet facilities The Sands Amusements for Mr Parnham – granted
06/08/0497/F proposed new bungalow at land to rear of 33 Ormesby Road (access off easterly Way) for Mr Skoyles – granted
06/08/0513/F extend permission for monitoring mast Old Met Station to 31 July 2010 - granted.
- Tendering specifications – these were amended for grasscutting, beach cleaning, handyperson/cleaner for the toilets and tending flower beds for 2009/2010. A Notice is to be placed in the GY Advertiser and on Parish Council Notices boards inviting people to tender.
- Burial Ground - it was agreed daffs will be planted in the Burial Ground on the large grassed area adjacent to the ashes plots in the shape of a large cross.
- Highways – a letter is to be sent to Norfolk County Council requesting they look into the following issues:
Beach Road at bottom – road narrows sign
Weeds growing through the newly laid footpath in Summerfield and Springfield North.
Refresh white markings on the highway Winterton Road, Beach Road, The Street, Kingsway roundabout and the zebra crossing.
