

MINUTES FOR HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING 19 JANUARY 2009

- The following planning applications were considered:
06/09/011/F proposed erection of new three bedroom house & garage 25-26 St Marys Road for Mr B Walsh –the Parish Council has no objections
06/09/0004/F proposed side ext to existing bungalow to form an additional bedroom 9 Four Acres for Mr Taylor –the Parish Council has no objections
06/09/0013/F 1st floor and roof space ext and alts to provide additional residential accommodation Fishermans Lodge, Newport Cottages for Mr Benson – PCllrs feel there would be an overdevelopment of the site and it is not in keeping with existing properties.
- Great Yarmouth Borough Council decisions on planning application:
06/08/0829/F renew PP car boots for PC – granted - copy of the PP given to PCllr Kyriacou.
- Hemsby Medical Centre feels they are unable to give up two parking spaces in the car park for people with disability - this would have relieved some of the pressure with disabled vehicles parking in front of the Centre.
- Highways - Parish Councillors are to meet with County Councillor Shrimplin to discuss various issues in Hemsby.
- Car Boots on the playing field - the Sporting Club is going out to tender for the Car Boots this year, if you are interested could you contact Keith Kyriacou on mobile 07932752353.
- Pontins - it was with sadness that Parish Councillors reported Pontins had closed and the future of the site is unknown.
- Extension to the Pavilion is around 2 weeks behind schedule; this is due to the weather so it should be completed in April 2009.
- Freedom of Information Act - the Parish Council adopted the Model Freedom of Information Act – a notice is to be placed in the Notice boards advising where a copy can be obtained.
- The next Parish Council meeting will be held 16 February 2009 at 7 30pm in the Parish Office.
