- Extension to the Pavilion and playing field - Grant package had been submitted to the Football Foundation and a Grant of £526,000 has been given to go towards the total costs of the works. The shortfall of £75,000 has just been obtained from the Public Works Loan Board at 3.090% interest rate, which is a short term loan. The Grant of £526,000 is the largest given to any organisation in the borough and the Parish Council realise they were lucky to have achieved this for the parishioners. The Pavilion extension should be completed in the very near future and the playing field will see footballers using it in October 2009.

- Election of Chairman Bob Reynolds was re-elected
- Election of Vice Chairman Lyndon Bevan was re-elected
- Mill Road footpath assessment had been carried out in March 2009, it achieved 27 points and is 305 on a priority list of 415.
- The following planning applications were considered:
06/09/0251/F installation of solar heating panel tubes 79 Common Road for Mr & Mrs C R King – Parish Council has no objections
06/09/0306/F ext to Fishermans Lodge Newport Cottages Newport for Mr G Benson – Parish Council feel there is an overdevelopment of the site and out of character with surrounding properties.
- Great Yarmouth Borough Council planning application decision:
06/09/0083/F installation of septic tank 257 The Marrams for Mr Helmsing – granted
- Appeal planning application decision made by Great Yarmouth Borough Council:
The erect 3 bed bungalow at 37 Mill Road the applicant has gone to appeal
- Conservation area status - it was agreed to request Great Yarmouth Borough Council to look into Conservation Status for Newport Cottages.
- Hemsby Coastal Group Chairman Lyndon Bevan, Parish Councillor Bensly, two G Watling trustees and Borough Councillor Weymouth went to Dunwich to look at the works that have been carried out there to protect the coast. Great Yarmouth Borough Council has produced a plan showing where and how much chestnut palling is required to be sited to protect the erosion of the dunes from Newport Cottages to Long Beach Estate.
- Hemsby Emergency Plan - Parish Councillors will then be delivering letters and questionnaires to all properties in the parish – the questionnaire will be collected by them within a few days. This is to find out if any parishioner can help in anyway in an emergency in the parish.
- The next Parish Council meeting will be held 15 June 2009 at 7 30pm in the Parish Office, Kingsway, Hemsby.
