HEMSBY WHAT WAS YOUR SAY FOR THE £10K

On a very cold and snowy Saturday 27th November the village came out to vote, well 65 brave souls and a dozen or so children did. The results are as below with the £10,000 of funding potentially able to support 8 different projects across the village.

With a total sum of £10,000 for services reinforced by a further £3,880 for capital works funding should cover all of the proposed projects except the three that received the fewest overall points.

HEMSBY WHAT WAS YOUR SAY FOR THE £10K

That is the flashing speed sign, the hearing loop for the village hall and further planting around the village. The administration costs of the whole process to date has been limited to £40, to cover the use of the barn room. The Parish council gave a grant to cover the costs of the ideas forms and posters, while steering group members covered lots of incidental expenses.

Over the next few weeks the steering group will be looking to get the projects started. There will be a wide range of schemes going forward, seeking to draw in further support for our village.
