

HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES OF THE MEETING 22 February 2010

- Police

Rogue traders are operating in the area – parishioners please be aware of the problem. Do not hand over any cash/cheques until the work has been completed to your satisfaction.
Theft of central heating oil – there has been another incident in the parish.

- Village Hall

The toilets have been refurbished and the main hall has been redecorated. They have a new Secretary and Treasurer which is working very well. To book the hall please telephone Wendy Bowgen on 01493 731411.

- Newport Cottages

The Parish Council is looking for any old photographs, postcards showing the properties as they were in the 1900's – please notify the Parish Clerk if you have any that could be copied.

- Demolished bus shelter Yarmouth Road

Great Yarmouth Borough Council are claiming against the owner of the vehicle – this will be a very long process, but it has started.

- Street lights in Hemsby

Great Yarmouth Borough Council are **not** adopting the same Policy as Norfolk County Council to turn the street lights off during the night.

- Area around the Parish Office and bus stop Kingsway

Concerns have been expressed at the fact the tree has been removed – unfortunately the roots were undermining the building so the Parish Council had no choice. This is a Norfolk County Council scheme funded by the Transport Department - 5No trees and shrubs will be planted as part of the scheme. The Video Shop in Kingsway have a plan showing the works to be carried out.

- Parish Burial Ground

The memorial regulations have been amended to fit in with the memorial stones that can be obtained by the stone masons.
