

## NOTES FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HOLD ON 20 SEPTEMBER 2010

- Borough Councillor Mrs Weymouth

a. Flooding due to heavy rainfall:

1. Waters Lane/Hall Road – too much water or a blockage as well
2. The Street - gully blocked with paper – that section was replaced by Norfolk County Council.
3. The Glebe – a property was flooded .

b. Bus stop in Yarmouth Road

Has been moved close to the Pumping Station

c. Cold Calling on the telephone – please be on your guard especially when being asked to carry out a survey – this could lead to you spending a lot of money.

- Hemsby Events Committee

The Carnival to be held on the 17 July 2011 the Parish Council has agreed to the closure of the Burial Ground Car Park to allow floats etc to gather there – say from 11.30am till 1.00pm

- Conservation area

Great Yarmouth Borough Council's draft conservation area survey/appraisal has been accepted by Parish Council.

- Allotments

A public meeting is to be held on Friday 8 October 2010 at 7 30pm in the Village Hall for those parishioners who have applied for an Allotment, this is to discuss the lease of the land.

- Burial Ground - Fees for burial, ashes plots and memorials

It was agreed to increase the fees by 10% as from 1 October 2010.

- Burial Ground Kingsway trees and shrubs

A contractor will trim them back.

06/10/11/F Hemsby Beach Holiday Village for Horning Pleasurecraft Ltd – granted

- Vandalism

Bus Shelter Yarmouth Road – panels kicked out on 18 September 2010 – the Parish Council carried out the repair to ensure there was no further damage. Because the bus shelter has been constructed similar to fence panels Parish Councillors suggested Great Yarmouth Borough Council should be contacted to see if they could put an inner lining of shuttering ply to make it more vandal proof.

- Hemsby Coastal Group

MP Brandon Lewis arranged for a Minister to look at the coastal issues for Hemsby, Winterton, Scratby and Hopton.
