

***NOTES FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HOLD ON 17 JANUARY 2011**

- *Burial of occupier of the Belle Aire Chalet Site Mr Jackson*

The meeting was advised that the Parish Council as a local authority has its own policies regarding the Burial Ground, that can be varied, it is different to the Common Law for Churchyards owned by the Church..

It was reported Belle Aire is a holiday chalet site in the parish and the planning permission is for holiday accommodation and the rates are charged accordingly. After discussions where it was pointed out that the Parish Council has a Policy that only people living in permanent accommodation could be buried, however the gentleman was a special case and on compassionate grounds the gentleman should be buried in the Burial Ground.

- Police

PCSO Pam Potter reported there have been 6 crimes since the last meeting 3 oil thefts in Barleycroft and 3 thefts – a person has been arrested. There are other oil thefts in Ormesby and Winterton. There is a problem with young drivers using the playing field car park as a race track it was left with the Police to monitor the situation.

 06/11/0002/CU retrospective application for change of use of garden to operate as a small wildlife rescue centre with associated cages – Tudor Lodge Newport Road for Mr Garner – no objections.

 06/10/0671/F ext to side and rear of property 6 Chapel Ter for Mr Clark – granted

- Wind Farm on Ormesby Road

The applicant is now taking the case to the High Court for a decision.

- Hemsby Medical Centre

They have ordered a handrail to make it easier for people to walk up the slope.

- Litter bins

Three litter bins are to be installed by GYB Services on the playing field.

- PB Grant £10k

From the public consultation there are 8 projects that will be looked into.
