- As Chair and Vice Chair are ill PCllr Brooks was elected to the Chair for the meeting.

- Police

Speed checks were carried out on 5/10 from Caister through to Hemsby – 2 tickets given, 1 speeding, 7 people warned.

PCSO Potter has been appointed as the parishes PCS Officer and if he is not in a position to attend meetings he will be sending a crime figures report monthly.

- Hemsby Events Committee

a. The Firework Event on 5 November – a meeting was held and letters sent to parishioners who complained last year about parking in Stable Fields. Mr Hirst has offered his Maize Maze car park for use as a car park for the firework event and Reynolds Coaches will be used as a 'park/ride' to take people to the PF.

b. Discussions are being held around the Hemsby Festival being moved to the Maize Maze at some time in the future.

- Affordable housing scheme

The Chairman, Great Yarmouth Borough Council Officer and the PClerk to meet with Housing Associations to see what they can offer.
