

NOTES FROM THE HEMSBY PARISH COUNCIL MEETING ON 16 APRIL 2012

- Trees on Kingsway grass verge overhanging parishioners properties in Barleycroft
Norfolk County Council has emailed GYB Services Tree Officer who is compiling a quote to remove trees that are compromising the fence of properties adjacent to Kingsway. Trees which have numerous trunks will be thinned and general pruning works will be carried out.

- Parish Council risk assessments
These will be carried out monthly by Mick Tingley

- Vehicles parking overnight on the playing field car park
Signs are to be purchased stating 'No overnight parking' by order of Hemsby Parish Council' these will be sited on the boundary fence.

- Long Beach Estate
Letters are to be sent to those properties on the Electoral Register for Winterton advising they live in the parish of Winterton not Hemsby.

- Planning application considered

- Erosion of sand dunes
A lot of dune/sandhill has gone and there was an accident on the beach – part of the dune came down and left a shelf of marram grass and sand and two young girls were buried in the sand. A parishioner and a gentleman from Winterton got them out. The emergency services were called and it took them around 30minutes to arrive at Hemsby.
