- Election of Chairman

- Police

PC Pam Potter gave the following report for 12th Dec- 16th Jan:

5 x criminal damage (All relating to Fakes Road 3 x Victims)

4 x Burglary other than dwellings (3 on campsites- Florida, Pontin's and Beach Estate and one in a empty property on Beach Road.)

2 x Assault (relating to one incident, 2 victims and offender has been arrested and is on bail)

There has been a significant rise in the past week of burglaries on the campsites, it has mainly been Scratby camps that have been targeted, but we have increased patrols on all sites in the area.

Norfolk County Council has advised physical traffic calming is no longer provided by them, and it is not something they would recommend as they cause so many problems.

c. Recorded accidents
